The Daniel Webster Family Home, also known as The Elms, is located in West Franklin, New Hampshire and has been designated a National Historic Landmark. Webster's father, Ebenezer, bought the house in 1800 when Daniel was a student at Dartmouth College. The property passed to Daniel's brother, Ezekiel, in 1806, and it was purchased by Daniel following Ezekiel's death in 1829.
