Unilateral Neglect: Mostly prominent in right-brain affected stroke patients, Unilateral Neglect (or Hemispatial Neglect) refers to an unawareness of objects to one side of the body or personal space. # How to Better Communicate with Stroke Patients

Stroke can sometimes damage the parts of the brain that receive, process and interpret information sent by the eyes. This can result in losing half the field of vision - for example, only being able to see the left or right side of what's in front of you. Stroke can also affect the control of the eye muscles. This can cause double vision.

# Stroke - Recovery - NHS

Hemiplegia or Hemiparesis: Impaired Mobility on the Right Side. A stroke on the left side of the body (in this case, the right half) and hemiparesis involves weakness on half of the body.

# Left Hemisphere Stroke: Side Effects, Treatment ...

Right brain stroke is a condition where the blood flow to the right hemisphere of the cerebrum is interrupted. Blood supply may stop when the blood vessel that carries oxygen to the brain gets blocked by blood clots or plaque build up inside the blood vessel.
