Different Welsh rivers have their own designs, tailored to the flow of the river. The Teifi coracle , for instance, is flat-bottomed, as it is designed to negotiate shallow rapids, common on the river in the summer, while the Carmarthen coracle is rounder and deeper, because it is used in tidal waters on the Tywi , where there are no rapids.
